CONCLUSION

14. Members appreciated the intent of the presentation and Council

a. Noted:

- i. That the State Action on Business Enabling Reforms (SABER) Programme is a USD 750 million performance-based initiative, implemented by the Federal Government with World Bank support, and extended to run through 2027.
- ii. That the Programme is designed to strengthen the business environment by improving land administration, promoting private investment in fibre optic infrastructure, enhancing Investment Promotion Agencies and Public-Private Partnership offices, and improving government-to-business service delivery.
- iii. That Lagos State is actively participating in the SABER Programme and continues to implement the required reforms to achieve the applicable Disbursement Linked Indicators (DLIs).
